(a) Two Year Integrated Post Graduate M.Sc. Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the subject concerned.

OR

Master's Degree from a recognized university with at least 50% marks in aggregate in the following subjects.

Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject/combination of subject and in aggregate. The elective subjects and languages in the combination of subjects are as under:

- i) B.Ed. or equivalent degree from a recognized University.
- ii) Pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) Paper-II, conducted by CBSE in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
- iii) Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English medium.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE POST OF TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS (PGT, TGTs & PRT)

- A. The candidate should possess the professional qualification of B.Ed. as on 04.11.2022.
- B. For the post of TGT (Social Studies):
 - 1. The candidate should have studied any two subjects out of the following:
 - (i) History with at least 50% marks in aggregate and one subject out of Geography/Economics/Political Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and also at least 50% marks in graduation

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(ii) Geography with 50% marks with History/Economics/Political Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and at least 50% marks in graduation.

- 2. Geography/History should have been studied in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks.
- 3. In case of Honors Degree in History, the candidate should have studied Geography/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with at least 50% marks in History in aggregate and at least 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and at least 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.
- 4. Similarly in case of Honors degree in Geography, the candidate should have studied History/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with at least 50% marks in Geography in aggregate and at least 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also at least 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.

OR Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) OR Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) * * Who has acquired the qualification of Bachelor of Education from any NCTE recognized institution shall be considered for appointment as a teacher in class I-V provided the person so appointed as a teacher shall mandatorily undergo a six month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE within two years of such appointment as Primary Teacher. 2. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test Paper (CTET Paper -I) conducted by the Govt. of India. 3. Proficiency to teach through Hindi & English media. Desirable:
